Entry for humanitarian visit under judicial permission, or visiting a relative who experiences catastrophic illness or injury. Entry for obtaining public law payment, or receive inheritance. 4. Entry for fulfilling contractual obligations or as part of internal transfers within multinational enterprises. 5.
